DISCIPLINE POLICY 2025-2026

The philosophy of Kids In Action School regarding discipline is necessary for the welfare of the student as well as the entire school and is based on the partnership of the home and school. Our school exists to provide a continuation of education that should first start in the home of our students. Effective classroom discipline is a necessary key ingredient for a good learning environment.

The purpose of discipline at Kids In Action School is not only to achieve this goal but also to help students learn self-discipline and good character traits, become self-directed members in the immediate environment and eventually as future members of a larger society. Discipline, or training up of a child, affords us all the opportunity to provide a safe, wholesome environment. The teacher is responsible to maintain appropriate classroom behavior. Certain behavior is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. Therefore, specific standards are set to see that each child is obedient, respectful and accountable for his/her actions and that Kids In Action School is fair in its enforcement of the rules.

As partners in the discipline process, home and school must maintain the same standards. We expect our students, your children, to adhere to all the rules that have been established in our institution. Failure to adhere will result in consequences ranging from loss of privileges to expulsion. In addition, each teacher is given the liberty of making and enforcing classroom rules in accordance with Christian principles and the school's discipline policy. However, the administration can and will make the final decision regarding disciplinary actions for any infraction, when warranted. Kids In Action School expects full cooperation from both students and parents regarding student discipline.

DISCIPLINE PLAN

When misconduct occurs, corrective measures will be used to help the student change his/her behavior and attitude. Examples of typical corrective measures may include, but are not limited to:

- 1.- Positive Reinforcement
- 2.- Loss of Privilege and other classroom consequences
- 3.- Time alone in Quiet Zone
- 4.- Phone call to parent
- 5.- Corrective Action Notice
- 6.- Parent conference
- 7.- Further disciplinary action includes detention/suspension/withdrawal/expulsion by the principal/school administration.

DISCIPLINE PROCESS: (*All levels can include the Principal/Director/Administratiion

In cases of serious or recurring problems, a parent may be required to pick up the child immediately. If the behavior or conduct of the student indicates an uncooperative spirit and there is no change within a designated time, the parent will be asked to have the student evaluated by a professional counselor or permanently withdraw the student from the school. The school reserves the right to dismiss a student immediately if, in the opinion of the administration, the student is not conforming to the school's policies.



Parents will be called to pick up any student who touches another student inappropriately or threatens to harm himself/herself or others, pending disciplinary action.

When the school feels that the student/parent cooperation is lacking, the parent may be requested to withdraw the student, or the student may be expelled. Attendance at Kids In Action School is a privilege and not a right. Students forfeit this privilege if they do not conform to the standards and ideals of work and life at Kids In Action School. An actual expulsion takes place after all the other listed attempts have failed. Notwithstanding, the school reserves the right to seek immediate expulsion if in its sole discretion the extenuating circumstances warrant such action.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT (Infraction of any standards of conduct will result in at least one level of the disciplinary process and/or one of the corrective measures).

- 1. Respect authority and peers.
- 2. Maintain standards of courtesy, kindness, morality and integrity.
- 3. Follow school dress code and code conduct.
- 4. No biting, hitting, pushing, shoving, kicking, scratching or fighting. No student shall intentionally engage in physical contact with other students except when appropriate as determined by the school.
- 5. No students shall intentionally engage in physical contact of any kind.
- 6. Students are expected not to engage in cheating, swearing, cursing, stealing.
- 7. All textbooks and notebooks must be kept in decent order. Three sharpened pencils, plus any books or supplies needed for classes on a given day MUST be brought to school on that day. Not having textbooks, notebooks, sharpened pencils, or needed supplies for class will affect student's performance.
- 8. No running unless on playground. No unruly behavior in the hallways, classrooms, cafeteria or any place on the school site used for instruction or school related activities.
- 9. No gum or gum chewing is permitted in school or during school trips.
- 10. No littering. All waste must be disposed of in garbage cans.
- 11. No trips without written parental consent, and school uniform
- 12. Except on designated "Show and Tell" days, students are not permitted to bring to school personal items that have no bearing on or use in the educational process. Radio, electronic toys, cell phones, etc. are not permitted. (This is not limited to listed items). Any object that the school feels distracts the learning process or classroom atmosphere will not be permitted. If students bring such items to school, the items will be confiscated, and the parent will be responsible for retrieving them. Subsequent violations will result in the parent

not being able to retrieve item(s) before the end of the school year.



- 13. Guns, matches, lighters, knives are not permitted, any student who possesses, sells, or otherwise furnishes a firearm, knife, explosive or any other dangerous object at school or at a school sponsored activity on or off campus will be subject to expulsion and police notification. Charges will be pressed, if applicable.
- 14. Marked on, defaced or broken property is to be replaced at offending student's expense.
- 15. Good personal hygiene is a must. We expect students to come to school clean and in uniform, and to keep themselves neat in school and on school trips. Students will be inspected daily for uniform and cleanliness.
- 16. Do not send your child to school with jewelry, money or other small objects on his/her person or in their pockets. Small objects can be extremely dangerous among young children. Finger rings and other non-essential jewelry will not be permitted.
- 17. Hats, caps or any other head covering must not be worn during school, except for designated show and tell or other special activities.
- 18. Girl's skirts must fall at least at the top of the knee.
- 19. All students must wear the required color socks and shoes.
- 20. All girls are required to wear navy shorts under their uniform.
- 21. Shoes should cover and protect the feet and allow for safety in running and playing. All students must wear closed-in shoes or sneakers. No open toe shoes, crocs, sandals, or boots of any kind are allowed, unless for designated/specified activities/events.
- 22. Kids In Action School stands in opposition to the drinking of alcohol, use of tobacco products and illegal drugs, pornography, homosexuality and fornication. We also stand in opposition to any other activity considered in Scripture to be worldly.
